YOUTH

**What do you think God wants for Highland's youth group?*

**Youth group is part of a congregation, not separate from it. In what ways does the congregation have part of the youth's lives? In what ways could they be more.*

**Today youth and their adults have fun opportunities and many activities and demands upon their time and life. So, what does a youth group offer that is unique? How does youth group become part of a parent and youth's life—supports and nourishes the other areas of life—rather than “one more” thing to do?*
